Only 90 miles from the U.S., Cuba has remained a forbidden territory since their socialist Revolution.

During this trip, we will learn the history of Cuba in a Latin American context, taking a close look at issues of global economics, conflict and peace, race, culture, the environment, and U.S. relations. We will:

- Examine Cuban national priorities, such as universal education and health care.
- Visit schools, museums, cultural and historical sites.
- Discuss with Cubans the effects of changes in U.S. & Cuban relations including the U.S. embargo on Cuba.
- Visit the Che Guevara Mausoleum at Santa Clara.
- Learn about Cuba's history of sugar production and slavery.
- Experience the sights, sounds, and tastes of old Havana, its neighborhoods, and the surrounding countryside.

**Deadline:** Applications and a \$350 non-refundable deposit are due by January 19, 2018. Half of the remaining balance is due by February 1, 2018, and the second half by February 15, 2018.

**Cost:** \$2,466 (with credit) or \$1,900 (with no credit). Scholarships may be available.

\*Price includes: visa fee, insurance, all meals, lodging, facilitation, interpretation, & Cuba transportation.

\*Price doesn't include: passport costs, airfare, and personal incidentals.
